Questions for Pastor...

"What is this "Network" thing we are doing in January . . .

... sounds like it has something to do with television or computers."

First off, Network has nothing to do with computers or television. But it has everything to do with God's vision. God's vision for His church (and remember, the church is people). A couple examples from Scripture:

Now you are the body of Christ, and each one of you is a part of it.... Now about spiritual gifts, brothers, I do not want you to be ignorant... There are different kinds of gifts, but the same Spirit. There are different kinds of service, but the same Lord. There are different kinds of working, but the same God works all of them in all men. Now to each one the manifestation of the Spirit is given for the common good." From 1 Corinthians 12:

Each one should use whatever gift he has received to serve others, faithfully administering God's grace in its various forms. If anyone serves, he should do it with the strength God provides, so that in all things God may be praised through Jesus Christ. To him be the glory and the power for ever and ever. Amen.

From 1 Peter 4

God's vision for His church is that each of us would use the spiritual gifts we have been given - and we have all been given gifts. We use the gifts God gave us to help others and give God glory (pointing others Jesus by our actions).

Ephesians 2:10 says, "We are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works which God has prepared in advance for us to do."

In other words:

- Before all creation, God prepared some ministry opportunities for you to do ("ministry" means "service")
- God created you
- God sent Jesus to make a relationship possible with you
- He called you to be part of His family through faith in Jesus
- He gave you His Holy Spirit who brought you to faith in Jesus
- He gave you a Spiritual gift to use
- He gave you the power of the Holy Spirit to minister to the body of Christ (church) with that gift.
- · He identified the works He has for you to do.
- He promises His continuous presence to help you.

Network is a study that will help you discover:

- Specific Spiritual gifts God has given you;
- 2. Specific aspects of ministry you have a passion for and
- 3. Ministries you can use your passion and gifts in.

Just as each part of the human body has a specific ability and task that the rest of the body needs. Likewise, each Christian, as part of the body of Christ, has a specific ability and task that the rest of the body needs. Make a point to come to <code>Network</code> and discover your spiritual gifts, your passion for ministry. The church (the rest of the body) needs you and your gift.

Network is a one-hour/week, six-week study. It will be held Monday evenings @ 7:00 p.m. (at Dan & Tammy Millers' home) beginning January 15. It will also be held at church on Sunday mornings @ 9:15 beginning January 20.

By the way, why the name <code>Network?</code> I checked a dictionary and found this definition of the word "network": "An interconnected or interrelated group." That definition fits pretty well with God's vision for His church. He designed us to be an interconnected and interrelated group of believers.

Wrapped up in His Presence are these other gifts

. . .

Comfort

- · There's great comfort in knowing your sins can be forgiven
- There's great comfort in knowing that in a world where everything changes, God's word never does. If He said it, you can bank on it. He won't change His mind.
- There's great comfort in knowing you aren't alone. God is there.
- There's great comfort in knowing that the God who is there is a God who loves you - no matter what.

<u>Joy</u>

- There is joy in actually receiving forgiveness of your sins.
- There is joy in knowing that because God kept His promise to come the first time, You can be sure He will keep His promise to return.
- There is joy in knowing that when He returns, you and all who believe in Jesus will rise in a renewed body to live forever on a renewed earth

Peace

- Jesus brought peace between sinful creation and a sinless God.
- We receive that peace when we surrender to Jesus and trust Him for eternal life
- We receive that peace daily when we surrender our will to Jesus' will.

Love

- Love is essential for life. We do all sorts of hurtful things when we don't get it.
- Love is not something to just talk about. The Bible is clear that love is something that must be demonstrated with actions. Jesus is "Love With Skin On"
- Love is "Doing for others what they can't do when it is in your power to do it."
- God showed that real love when He came to earth to pay the way for us to get into heaven (something we could

never have done due to our sin)

We need each of these gifts not just at Christmas time but every day.

But how do we "unwrap" the gift of God's Presence and receive them?

- · Come to Worship -
 - "Where two or three are gathered in my name, there am I in the midst of them"
- Come to the Lord's Supper -God's presence comes to us individually in the most personal of ways.
- Open Your Bible and Read God is present with His wisdom, guidance and power for
 your life.
- Pray -God is present to listen and answer with the best answer

The Example of the Wise Men

We don't know a lot about these guys. We don't know exactly how many there were or exactly where they came from. We don't know their names or exactly what they spent their time doing. But we do know one very important thing:

They made a priority of seeking Jesus and worshiping Him.

One way they worshiped Jesus was by bringing Him gifts.

One of those gifts was gold - earthly treasure.

Some things haven't changed over the past 2000 years. One of the ways we have of giving Jesus our worship is by bringing Him our gifts of earthly treasure. And in one of our daily Bible readings (1 Chronicles 29:14) King David reminds us that all of our earthly treasure comes from God. We acknowledge that fact by giving back to God a portion of the earthly treasure He's given us. (Our tithes and offerings)

This month each of us will have the opportunity to determine the gifts of earthly treasure that we will commit to bring to God as an act of worship.

A Minute for Parents...

Set an example by giving an "After-Christmas" Gift that keeps on giving.

(The same one God gave us at Christmas)

By now some of the Christmas presents you gave your kids have become broken. Others have been forgotten. Hopefully some are still in use. But the start of a new year would be a great time to resolve to give your children the present they really want most - your presence.

His presence is the present God gave us at Christmas. It's the one he has promised to give us until the end of time "And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age." Mt. 28:20

Of all the things my parents did to show their love, the things that stick in my mind most are the times they made a special effort to just "be there." Chance are the same can be said for you. And chances are that is what your kids will remember too

How can you spend more time with your children - collectively and individually? After school? In the evening? On the weekends?

Maybe read them a story instead of reading the newspaper. Play a game with them instead of watching TV. Plan a special project that you can work on together. Have a "Date Your Kid" night once a week. Set aside one night as "Family night." Get their input on what they would like to do on those days. Sit down with them and plan what you will do then put it on the calendar.

"Being there" isn't limited to the kids that still live under your roof. When could you "be there" for your kids that are away at college? When could you "be there" for those children that live on their own?

Be A Secret Paul...

This spring at Living Word we went through a study called "Battle Cry for a Generation." We were reminded of the need to be involved in the lives of the young people of our congregation and to be for them what a church should be - a caring, extended family.

One idea that came out of our study was to pair up each young person with an adult who would commit to pray for them daily. As a way of also getting the young people involved it was suggested that we have each one of them commit to pray daily for an adult in the congregation. We then expanded on that idea and decided to include the entire congregation in the prayer program. "Secret Paul" is the name we have chosen for this "prayer pal" program.

In coming up with a name for our program we were reminded that the Apostle Paul was noted for praying for other believers every day. Paul prayed for their protection. He prayed for them to grow in their faith. He prayed for them to keep putting their faith into action. He said prayers of thanks for them. We will seek to follow Paul's example and be in prayer daily for each other.

The "Secret" part of the program name comes from the fact that we will not reveal who is praying for whom until the end of the year at a special banquet. We will be "secret prayer pals" or "Secret Pauls" for each other.

As part of the program each person will receive a packet of information about the person you are paired up to pray for. That packet will include a picture, birth date, hobbies/interests and special prayer needs.

That brings us to what we need from you right now: Please fill out and return the information card you received in your mailbox at church. It will include information you want put in the packet to be given to the "Secret Paul" who will pray for you.

This is a church-wide program, but if you don't want to be included please let us know.
